

## Ghosts Are Dancing

### Summary of Posts

Aftermath of a war. The gods have turned all the adults into teenagers as a form of revenge.

- Frame 1      Images of the war. Soldiers run at each other, fight, die. Greeks win, Trojans lose  
Hektor fights Achilles. Dies  
Hekuba (Queen of Troy) kills Achilles, who takes some time to die  
Paris tells Hekuba he is leaving, and is killed
- Frame 2      Hekuba meets her daughter Polyxena at the water's edge  
Odysseos tells Hekuba that Polyxena must die, at the request of Achilles' ghost  
Polyxena agrees to die, but on her own terms
- Frame 3      Chorus sings of their former lives, forever gone
- Frame 4      Talthibios guides the body of Polydoros across the water to the shore  
Polydoros tells Hekuba he was killed by Polymestor, tasked with protecting him
- Frame 5      The Chorus sings of being caught in-between lives
- Frame 6      Agamemnon chases Cassandra, courting her  
Cassandra talks to ghosts  
Hekuba offers to negotiate on his behalf with her daughter  
Agamemnon agrees to invite Polymestor to Troy
- Frame 7      Chorus sings of Revenge
- Frame 8      Polymestor arrives with his children  
Hekuba promises gold and sexual favours  
Polymestor enters the Trojan tents and is blinded by Hekuba  
His children are killed by the Trojan females  
Agamemnon arrives. Polymestor appeals for his support  
Polymestor admits his crimes and rants at Hekuba  
Polymestor is exiled  
The dance of the dead and the living
